5. All eligibility and technical documents of the participants must be submitted to the BAC on or before 14 July 2015, 12:00 noon together with their best and final offer as to the price. Evaluation and screening of the said documents shall be conducted by the BAC on 14 July 2015 at 2:00 pm at the Philippine Embassy, 23 Xiu Shui Bei Jie, Jian Guo Men Wai, Beijing, China.
6. The best and final price offer of all participants shall be placed in envelopes and must be properly sealed, labeled and signed. Late bids shall not be accepted.
7. The BAC shall select the successful offer on the basis of such best and final offer which should meet the project's minimum technical requirements and should not exceed the approved budget.
8. The BAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the negotiation process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without incurring any liability to the affected participants, pursuant to section 41 of the revised IRR of RA 9184.
