## WHO ApartTogether Survey

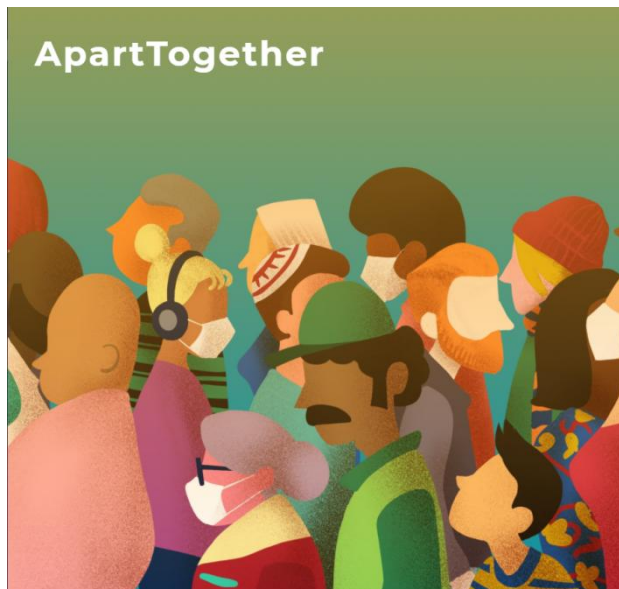

The Philippine Embassy in Beijing, China enjoins Filipinos who have migrated to other countries including their Philippine-born children aged 16 years old and above, OFWs, including those who lost jobs and those stranded due to the COVID-19 pandemic to take part in the World Health Organization's (WHO) **ApartTogether Survey**, which is available in 37 languages, including English and *Tagalog*, through the following web links:

*ApartTogether* is a global study which aims to better understand the psychosocial impact of COVID-19 on refugees and migrants. The results of the survey will be used to inform and support policy and decision-makers on how they can better support refugees and migrants during and after this global health crisis.

*ApartTogether* is a collaboration between WHO, across its regional offices, the UN System, and a consortium of research centers led by Ghent University (Belgium) and University of Copenhagen (Denmark).

The responses will ensure that the situation of Filipinos will be considered in any new policies because of the COVID-19 pandemic.
